## Prerequisites for earning a CCHS Bands stole for graduation

The stole is intended to recognize CCHS Band students who have gone above and beyond the normal rhetoric of the daily band rehearsal and distinguished themselves as true representations of the Band ethos. With that, a senior may qualify for a stole if the following qualifications are met:

- 1. The student MUST have a minimum of 3 years of being a member of an auditioned band (Symphony Band OR Jazz Band).
- 2. Students must not have audited the Symphony or Jazz Band class for more than ONE year.
- 3. Students may ONLY qualify for a 2-year audit IF they are in the Symphony/Jazz Band their SENIOR year. No exceptions.
- 4. Drum Majors qualify for a stole.
- 5. Concert Band, Marching Band, Color Guard, or IB Music membership does NOT qualify for a stole.

In addition to the above-mentioned prerequisites, a qualifying senior must also:

- 1. Owe no debt to the CCHS Bands (marching fair shares, trip fees, lesson fees, etc.)
- 2. Perform an approved piece for their Senior Recital.
- 3. Be current on ALL lessons and receive a final approval of completion letter from their lesson teacher.
- 4. Pass with a minimum grade of a "B" on their Final Jury.

Qualified students will need to fill out a Director Approval Form prior to receiving their stole.
